Whilst we encourage lively conversation and civil debate, please do not attack others, adopt a rude tone, or talk over other participants. Defamatory, abusive, profane, threatening and offensive language will not be tolerated.

If we see or are made aware of any harassment, inappropriate language, aggression or purposeful derailment of discussions/meetings, we will issue warnings and may even, in extreme situations, eject participants (without refund). If asked to stop inappropriate behaviour, participants will be expected to comply immediately. We reserve the right to refuse entry to anyone who does not comply with our code of conduct. The code applies both in person and online. All of the above applies in equal measure to WFC Trustees, both at WFC events and committee meetings.
